I refer to your correspondence of 15 July 2020 concerning your request for your association to become an approved collectors' association under the Explosives Regulation 2017. The information you have provided has satisfied me that your association meets the criteria outlined in Section 176 of the Explosives Regulation 2017.

Accordingly, the Australian Arms Munitions and Militaria Historical Society Inc is hereby declared, pursuant to Section 176 of the Explosives Regulation 2017, to be an approved collectors' association.

Members of the Australian Arms Munitions and Militaria Historical Society Inc are authorised to possess, sell, transport and store collectors ammunition including:

1. small arms ammunition, being ammunition for a shotgun or ammunition for a firearm of calibre not greater than 25.4mm (including small arms ammunition with a projectile intended to contain an incendiary, tracer, explosive, lachrymatory or noxious composition, provided that the projectile has been rendered inert and free from explosives); and
2. other ammunition that does not contain explosive composition (e.g. grenades, mortars, shells, cartridge cases).

I have taken the opportunity of including a copy of Explosives Information Bulletin No. 20, covering Ammunition Collectors, for the benefit of your members. Copies may be accessed from our website or by direct mail.
